A Free Alternative - Helping You, Helping Us

Because we use The Marriage and Family Center as an educational training ground for our masters level interns, we are able to offer **three free counseling sessions** for couples or families, only, who you refer to us. A Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist will work with the clients during three sessions; however, they will be discreetly observed by some intern therapists through a one-way mirror. After the initial three free sessions, clients have an option to continue counseling with an intern therapist at the Center and pay an agreed upon fee. 





Premarital Counseling Options

Our intern therapists have been trained to use the well known PREPARE/ENRICH program for couples desiring marriage. They are also trained to use the Myers-Briggs Type Indicator (MBTI), which helps couples better understand themselves and each other.
