


## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

In cooperation with Evangelical Seminary's School of Lifelong Learning, **Institute for Church Leadership** offers a series of courses in Bible, theology, prayer, evangelism, church history, missions, counseling and more. Anyone can benefit from these opportunities for spiritual enrichment and leadership development. Evangelical is pleased to offer these classes as a resource for building the Kingdom of God.

These classes are open to all, without any educational prerequisites. They are not seminary level courses and do not earn official credit from Evangelical Seminary. The classes meet once a week for seven weeks on Tuesday evenings from 6:30 - 9:15, offered in a three year cycle with two courses in the fall and two courses in the spring. A synchronous online option is also available.
