- Work with a team to develop additional ministry opportunities in park communities
- Interact with co-workers from other countries who are in the US through a work visa
- Participate in a professional leadership development assessment through The Lions Lead
- Receive interpretation of their assessment results and coaching as they create a strategic plan for developing their skills during their summer experience
- Interact with a mentor/coach if required as a part of a field education class
- Experience in-person training in preparation for the unique ministry opportunities in a park
- Receive a \$2,000 scholarship/stipend from ACMNP at the end of their ministry season

In an effort to provide impactful ministry to park communities and support the understaffed national park communities we serve, we are still recruiting team members for this summer. In fact, we have created an in-person training conference on May 20-22 in St. Louis to accommodate new applicants.
